<p><b>Update report:</b></p> <p>The NHS Resolution (NHSR) CNST Maternity Incentive Scheme (MIS) requires Trust Boards to approve the evidence provided by the Trust Maternity Service which meets compliance with the MIS 10 Safety Actions.</p> <p>The maternity service has achieved the 10 MIS Safety Actions with the evidence collated demonstrating compliance requiring approval and sign off by the Trust Board and CEO by 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021.</p> <p>Kingston Maternity Service has also discussed the Trust MIS 10 Safety Actions compliance with commissioners via the SWL Local Maternity System.</p> <p>As per Standing Order 3.5.2, the Board is allowed to made decisions by email or correspondence (written resolution), should it not be possible to do so at a meeting. As the submission needed to occur before this Board meeting, Board members provided written approval for the Trust to submit to NHSR.</p> <p>A signed submission was made on 19<sup>th</sup> July, and confirmation of receipt provided by NHSR.</p> <p>The Board is asked to note the submission.</p>
