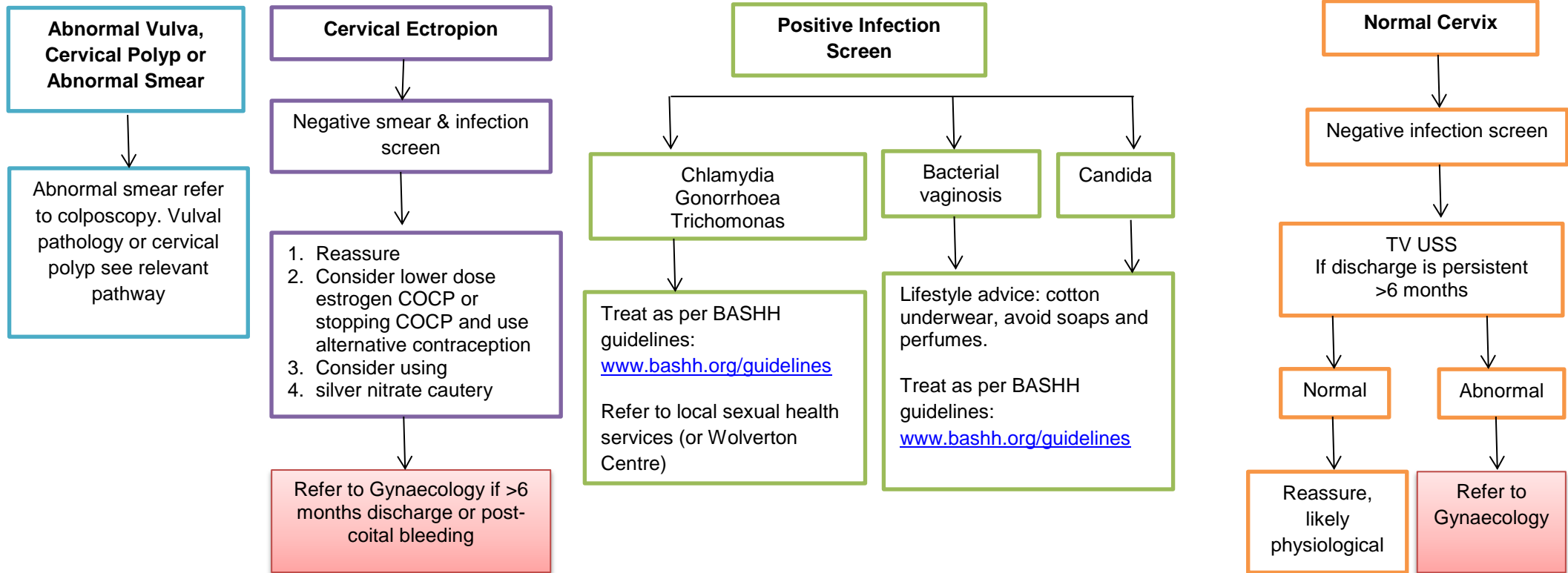


PERSISTENT VAGINAL DISCHARGE

Initial investigations:

1. Speculum + pelvic exam
2. HVS + endocervical swab + NAAT for GC/Chlamydia
3. Check cervical smear is up to date (cervical smear only to be performed if the patient is due a smear as per the cervical screening guidelines)



2-week Pan-London suspected cancer referral criteria

- Abnormal looking cervix
- Unexplained palpable mass in or at entrance to vagina
- Unexplained lump, ulceration or bleeding
- Abnormal looking cervix
