

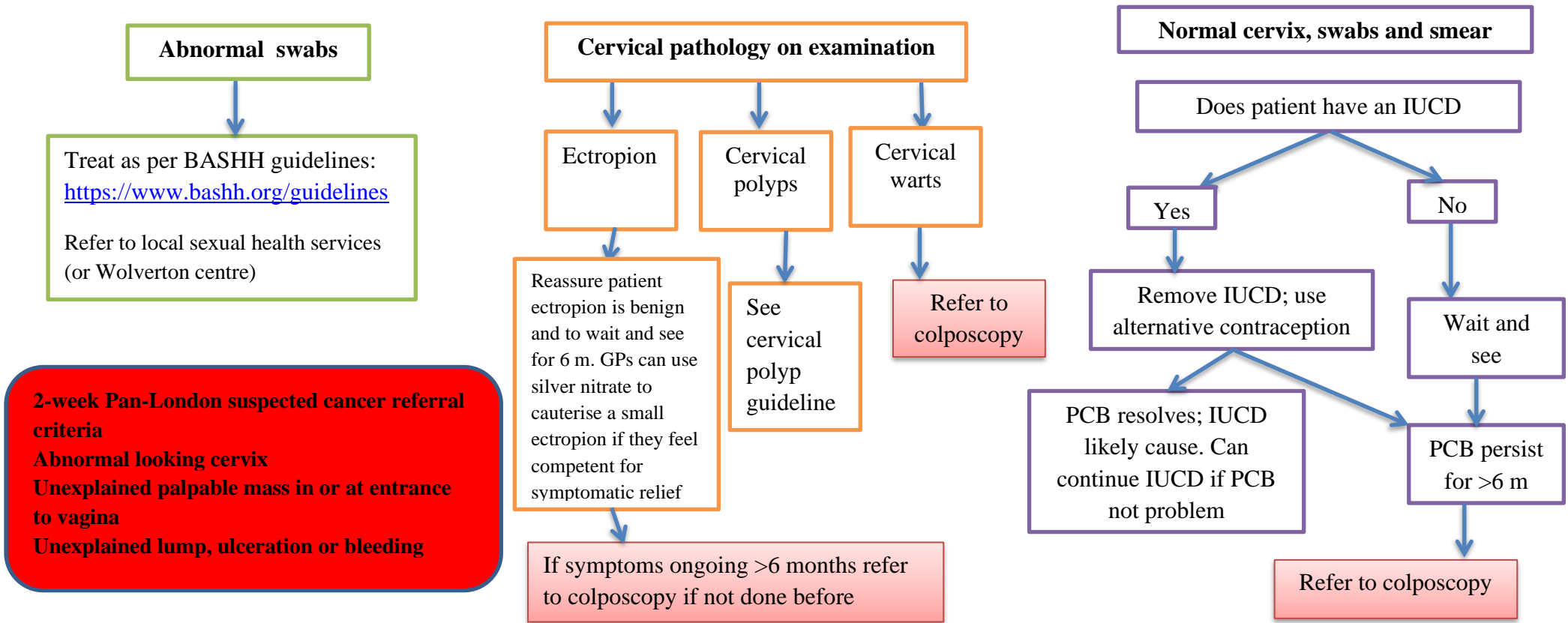

Post-coital bleeding (isolated)

(For PCB associated with IMB follow IMB pathway)

Initial investigations:

1. Speculum + pelvic exam
2. HVS + endocervical swab +NAAT for GC/Chlamydia
3. Check cervical smear is up to date (cervical smear only to be performed if the patient is due a smear as per the cervical screening guidelines)



2-week Pan-London suspected cancer referral criteria
 Abnormal looking cervix
 Unexplained palpable mass in or at entrance to vagina
 Unexplained lump, ulceration or bleeding

Please note: If patient has already had a normal colposcopy for PCB in the past please refer to Gynaecology
